RESPONSIBILITIES: (OTHER DUTIES MAY BE ASSIGNED)

- Complete site control, boundary reconnaissance, construction staking and topographic surveys
- Perform 3D scanning, and other surveying services in support of engineering work
- Review of maps, field notes, and exhibits; performing construction staking calculations for improvements and utilities
- Support surveying and mapping activities for boundary surveys, topographic mapping and construction staking projects
- Assist the Party Chief with all aspects of the daily crew assignment
- Work independently as a one person crew as required
- Operate, on a daily basis, various surveying instruments
- Maintain survey equipment and supplies
- Work in a safe manner and obey all safety regulations
- Continually advance knowledge with upgrades in technology
